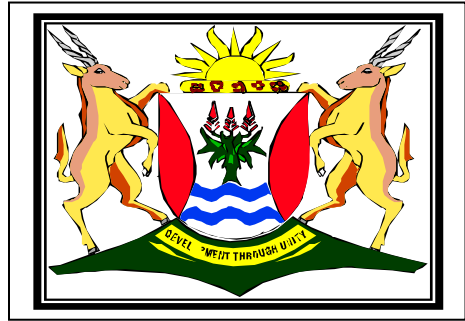

SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Learners have to comply with the instructions and the general rules of the school.
- Behave respectfully towards all employees of Advent High and with consideration for their fellow learners. Behave at all times in a dignified and self controlled manner, in keeping with the high standards of Advent Comprehensive School. Cases of attempted intimidation, inciting violence, harassment, bullying and insubordination in classrooms or elsewhere will not be tolerated.
- Behave responsibly and not endanger the safety and welfare of the school community.
- Respect and take care of the property of the school and refrain from littering.
- Be present at all times during school hours, unless there is a written permission of absence by the school director.
- Arrive punctually in the mornings and for each period. It is compulsory for all the learners to attend prayers that are conducted along Christian principles as propounded in the doctrines of the Seventh Day Adventist Church; much important work is lost through late coming, and the learner will be penalised for being late.
- Fulfil all school work commitments: class works, class tests, controlled tests, homework, projects etc. No cheating or copying will be tolerated.
- Wear full school uniform and maintain a neat appearance at all times. Any outfits that is not school uniform will be confiscated and the offender will be punished severely.
- Cell phones policy has been revised and a special extract on phone police is attached as an annexure to this form but a short summary is that all learners need have a 8 inch table with these special condition : fully insured with proof of insurance to be submitted upon arrival in the office, fully protected with a

paunch and screen guard, parents to supply a minimum of 1 gig per month straight to the students cell number. Any other game or entertainment (e.g. Cards, stereos, CD players and chess) should not be brought to school. **If any of these items are found it will be confiscated indefinitely.**

10. The use of drugs is prohibited and no learners should come to school under the influence of any form of intoxicating drugs. Learners will be deregistered from the school for trafficking drugs, alcohol and tobacco and also for being found/caught in possession of drugs, alcohol and tobacco at school. Learners must not chew gums in class while lessons are going on, nor are learners permitted to smoke on school premises at school related occasions. No loitering while classes are going on. Irregular attendance, bunking classes and students will be de- registered if they are involved in use of drugs, alcohol and smoking.

11. Medication with high content of caffeine, codeine, chicory and alcohol should be declared upon arrival at school so that the school can administer and regulate its use.

12. Hairstyle – No bonding

_ No dreadlocks for both boys & girls.

13. Uniform skirts should not be more than two fingers above the knees.

14. No jewellery (e.g. Necklaces, earrings, tongue/toe/rings)

15. No painting of nails

HOSTEL RULES AND REGULATIONS

WE PROVIDE:

- 24 hour adult supervision
- Fully furnished facilities
- Three meals per day
- Separate lodging for both boys and girls
- A disciplined and Christian environment
- Supervised homework sessions
- Recreational facilities
- Tuck-shop facility
- Security system and guard

WE EXPECT:

- Boarders to co-operate, be well behaved and to adhere strictly to hostel rules.
- Parents to make every effort to support our efforts to provide a well structured environment.
- All fees must be paid on time.
- **Pupils should report to the hostel a day before the school starts each term between 2 and 3 pm.**
- **Boarders should be collected before 4pm on the last day of the school term.**
- **Strict worship on Sabbath(Saturday) from Friday sunset to Saturday sunset.**

BASIC BOARDING RULES:

- No boy will be allowed on the girls' premises or vice versa.
- Boarders must stick strictly to the hostel time table
- Boarders will be expelled for sexual misconduct or harassment, any criminal behaviour, negative political agitation, unexpected absence from the hostel sessions, use or possession of drugs or alcohol or weapons/toys, disrespect to staff and abuse of property and vandalism.
- Boarders will treat the management of the hostel with complete respect and co-operation.
- Parents should pick up their children from the hostel at the end of the term and don't leave the risk of travelling home solely with the learners.
- The school does not have any place for learners who will take property of any school community member without consent, regardless of the size of the item. The offender will be forced to replace that item immediately, be subjected to a hefty fine; and may even be dismissed from school, for God has put it point blank that "THOU SHALL NOT STEAL" Exodus 20:1 vs. 15.
- The management reserves the right to add to, or amend these rules.
- Small offenses committed by boarders will result in demerits, and if too many demerits have been accrued the learner will be deregistered from the hostel and the school.

AGREEMENT ON FEES PAYMENT 2019

1. We/I, the undersigned, hereby undertake to pay to “Advent Comprehensive High School” (hereinafter called “the school”), the amount to be raised in advance each month, in respect of school fees for:

The School is an Independent (private) school and is registered with the Department of Education Emis number: 501 564, the School therefore receives no monthly financial assistance from the government and as such the fees are compulsory and parents are not entitled to apply for any form of fee exemption.

2. We/I hereby undertake to pay the full monthly school fees on or before the 2nd of every month. We/I understand that we/I may pay the fees monthly in 12 (twelve) equal instalments by the 2nd of each month. Should any one instalment not be paid on due date, the full amount will become due, owing and payable. We/I understand that non-payment of fees automatically gives the School the right to terminate the Learner’s enrolment at the school. We/I further acknowledge that while fees remain unpaid, the Learner’s enrolment status is a temporary nature, on a week-to-week basis; and that during this time the School is entitled to terminate enrolment at any time on written notification to withdraw the Learner.
