SCHOOL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Learners have to comply with the instructions and the general rules of the school.
2. Behave respectfully towards all employees of Advent High and with consideration for their fellow learners. Behave at all times in a dignified and self-controlled manner, in keeping with the high standards of Advent Comprehensive School. Cases of attempted intimidation, inciting violence, harassment, bullying and insubordination in classrooms or elsewhere will not be tolerated.
3. Behave responsibly and not endanger the safety and welfare of the school community.
4. Respect and take care of the property of the school and refrain from littering.
5. Learners have to be present at all times during school hours, unless there is a written permission of absence by the school director.
6. Arrive punctually in the mornings and for each period. It is compulsory for all the learners to attend prayers that are conducted along Christian principles as propounded in the doctrines of the Seventh Day Adventist Church; much important work is lost through late coming, and the learner will be penalised for being late.
7. Fulfil all school work commitments: class works, class tests, controlled tests, homework, projects etc. No cheating or copying will be tolerated.
8. Wear full school uniform and maintain a neat appearance at all times. Any outfit that is not school uniform will be confiscated and the offender will be punished severely.
9. Cell phones and tablets are strictly prohibited.
10. The use of drugs is prohibited and no learners should come to school under the influence of any form of intoxicating drugs. Learners will be deregistered from the school for usage and trafficking drugs, alcohol and tobacco and also for being found/caught in possession of drugs, alcohol and tobacco at school. Learners must not chew gums in class while lessons are going on, nor are learners permitted to smoke on school premises or at school related occasions. No loitering while classes are going on. Irregular attendance, bunking classes and may attract a severe penalty ranging from detention, manual labour, suspension and ultimately deregistration from the school.
11. Medication with high content of caffeine, codeine, chicory and alcohol should be declared upon arrival at school so that the school can administer and regulate its use.
12. Hairstyle – No bonding No dreadlocks for both boys & girls.
13. Uniform skirts should not be more than two fingers above the knees.
14. No jewellery (e.g. Necklaces, earrings, tongue/toe/rings) nor painting of nails.
